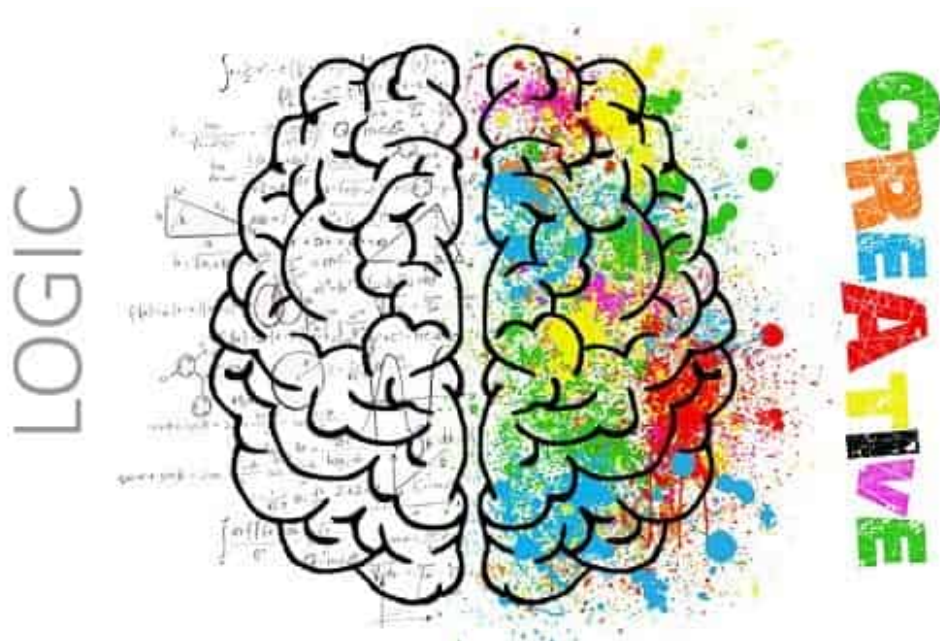
Goals and Objectives of Crash Course Psychology

Here's the main difference: the heart coursework. A BS in Psychology will demand more science- and math-related classes. You will jump to labs, study, and quantitative data.

Undergraduates who earn a BS pursue characters in medicine, science, and outside. Those with a BA in psychology tend to follow counseling roles.

Salary of psychologists

What is the usual salary of a Psychologist? Psychologists (in their many career forms) can make an incredibly lucrative income, particularly with advanced degrees. Don't expect the same from a Psychology crash course. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, psychologists earn anywhere from \$79k to \$129k per year.

The reduced income brackets fall to [clinical](#) and counseling psychologists. However, the higher annual incomes usually are to get industrial-organizational psychologists. The job outlook for psychology graduates appears increasingly positive, too. In the subsequent seven years, psychologists will see job growth of 14 percent.
